KAIKOURA, NEW ZEALAND

Kaikoura draws visitors from all over the world for the prolific marine life in the surrounding waters. Whale (including sperm whales), dolphin and seal watching tours operate year-round.

PORT CHALMERS (DUNEDIN), NEW ZEALAND

Founded in 1848, Port Chalmers is the main port for the city of Dunedin. Today, numerous distinctive and historic buildings remain from the time of its predominantly Scottish settlers, preserving its architectural heritage.

TAURANGA (ROTORUA), NEW ZEALAND

Tauranga is the gateway to the Rotorua Thermal Area, a picturesque region of towering geysers, bubbling mud pots, steam vents and other volcanic phenomena.

MILFORD SOUND, NEW ZEALAND

New Zealand's most famous tourist destination, Milford Sound is a part of the Fiordland National Park and the Te Wahipounamu UNESCO World Heritage Site on the South Island.

MELBOURNE, AUSTRALIA

Melbourne boomed in the Victorian gold rush, and by 1865 was the second-largest city in the British Empire. Today, Melbourne is ranked as one of the world's most livable cities.









Oban hangs beneath the South Island and is just about the last inhabited place before Antarctica. The island itself is only about four percent inhabited, and that is its attraction. It is a pristine piece of primeval New Zealand.

WELLINGTON, NEW ZEALAND

Wellington is nestled between a magnificent harbor and a natural amphitheatre of forest-clad hills. Its compact size, combined with cultural sophistication, makes it New Zealand's most inspiring urban destination.

PHILLIP ISLAND, VICTORIA, AUSTRALIA

The best of Australia all comes together across nature reserves with kangaroos, fur seals, occasional dolphins, whales, and the sunset "penguin march" as the birds return to their beach nests.

PICTON, NEW ZEALAND

Picton sits at the head of the Queen Charlotte Sound offering access to the Marlborough wine country, other spectacular sites and outdoor activities such as kayaking, fishing and cycling.

Sir Bani Yas is a huge ecological experiment that explores "greening the desert" by re-introducing native and endangered species. The island is a popular resort, where visitors indulge in active land and water sports and walk or drive to view free-roaming wild animals.

COCHIN, INDIA

Cochin is a vibrant city situated on the southwest coast of the Indian peninsula. It has one of the finest natural harbors in the world and for centuries was the center of the spice trade.

ASIA Featured ports

HO CHI MINH CITY, VIETNAM

Ho Chi Minh City covers an area of more than 800 square miles. Its land is overwhelmingly rural, dotted with villages and clusters of houses set amidst rice paddies.

LAEM CHABANG (BANGKOK), THAILAND

Bangkok is a city of endless fascination. It is an exhilarating mix of chaos and refinement. There is a wealth of history and culture to be discovered here: palaces, temples, markets, and exquisite classical Thai dance performances.

HALONG BAY, VIETNAM

Scattered among picturesque karstic islands, communities of fishing families live on sampans, periodically going into towns such as Haiphong to sell their catch and buy supplies.

SIHANOUKVILLE, CAMBODIA

Sihanoukville, is located in southern Cambodia on the Gulf of Thailand, and is Cambodia's only international marine port. Its beaches are the most prominent natural feature of the city, spanning most of the surrounding coastline.

HONG KONG, CHINA

One of the most exotic and exciting cities in the world, Hong Kong is loved by both tourists and its citizens for its scenic beauty, fabulous shopping, and memorable dining.







SINGAPORE

With ultra-modern skyscrapers and Chinese, Indian and Malay influences, Singapore is rich in contrast and color, with a lovely blend of culture, cuisine, arts and architecture.

DA NANG (HUE), VIETNAM

Da Nang, known as Tourane by the French, succeeded Hoi An as the most important port in central Vietnam during the 19th century. Among the Da Nang area sites of interest to visitors are the Marble Mountains, China Beach, the ancient port town of Hoi An and the imperial city of Hue.

PORT KLANG (KUALA LUMPUR), MALAYSIA
